

## Welcome to Elgar House Vaccination Centre

So, you've booked your vaccination appointment - What happens next?





Please come to Elgar House Reception at the time booked. You will be greeted by Stuart or Martin, our Site Managers.

Stuart or Martin will direct you to your vaccination room.



You will be the only person being vaccinated in the room. There will be a vaccinator and administrator in the room with you.

The vaccinator will ask you some health questions before giving you your vaccination. Please don't be afraid to ask about anything that is worrying you. Our staff are very friendly and are here to help you.



The vaccination is given through a tiny needle into your arm or leg. It may hurt a little, but will be over very quickly. The vaccinator will check you're feeling OK and then you'll be able to go.

After the injection, you may have an achy arm or a raised temperature. These usually go after a couple of days and can be treated with painkillers, such as paracetamol.



Thank you for coming forward for your vaccination. In doing so, you are protecting yourself, your friends and family and the NHS!
